

Kansas CNA Certification Checklist

□ Complete a 90-hour approved CNA training program that includes:

- 20 hours of didactic or classroom training
- 20 hours of supervised laboratory and clinical instruction
- 25 hours of advanced didactic or classroom instruction
- 25 hours of supervised clinical instruction in a licensed adult care home

□ Submit a Nurse Aide Training & Competency Evaluation Program (NATCEP) Checklist completed by an RN testing the applicant's Resident Care Knowledge and Skill

 $\hfill\square$ Score 75% or higher on the state CNA exam

Must pass the exam within 3 attempts and 12 months of the date the applicant began their CNA training course.
