



Kentucky CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete an approved CNA course of at least 75 hours, including 16 hours of supervised clinical training
- Create a Kentucky Board of Nursing Nurse Portal account
- Upload required documents during application
- Pass the written and skills competency exams administered by the Kentucky Community and Technical College System at various colleges throughout the state

CNAs are called State Registered Nurse Aides (SRNAs) in Kentucky.
