



Maine CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete a 130-hour Maine-approved CNA training program that includes:
 - 70 hours of classroom theory
 - 20 hours of clinical lab work
 - 40 hours of supervised clinical practice

- Pass the Maine CNA competency written or oral exam administered directly by the State or a State-approved entity that isn't a Medicaid-participating nursing or skilled nursing facility

- Pass the Maine CNA skills demonstration performed in a facility comparable to the setting where the applicant will work as a nurse aide

- Pass a criminal background check

- Complete and submit the online CNA Application or submit the PDF version via mail, email or fax with the appropriate documentation attached

Applicants must be at least 16 years old and may complete a "Non-Traditional CNA Competency Testing Evaluation" in place of traditional competency testing.
