



Missouri CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete a state-approved CNA course comprised of 75 hours of classroom training and 100 hours of on-the-job training or challenge the exam if eligible
- Meet all federal and/or state requirements
- Pass the two-part (written/oral knowledge and skills) competency exam administered by D&S Diversified Technologies/Headmaster within 1 year of the start date of training
- Get listed on the Missouri Certified Nurse Aide Registry (MOCNAR)

Must pass both parts of the exam within 3 attempts within a 90-day window or repeat the entire basic course before retesting.

Applicants challenging the exam only have one attempt to pass both parts before completing the full CNA course is required.
