

Nebraska CNA Certification Checklist

□ Have no convictions for a crime involving moral turpitude related to the nurse aide position

□ Be able to speak and understand English or the language understood by a substantial portion of the nursing home residents

□ Reached at least 16 years of age

□ Complete a state-approved training program consisting of at least 75 hours or a 21hour basic resident-care course for intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled

□ Complete one hour of Nebraska-specific abuse/neglect/misappropriation training

□ Pass the Nebraska-approved written/oral exam and skills competency exam

□ Wait for the facility employer to complete and submit the Registry form to put your name on the state's registry upon hire
