



## Nebraska CNA Certification Checklist

- Have no convictions for a crime involving moral turpitude related to the nurse aide position
- Be able to speak and understand English or the language understood by a substantial portion of the nursing home residents
- Reached at least 16 years of age
- Complete a state-approved training program consisting of at least 75 hours or a 21-hour basic resident-care course for intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled
- Complete one hour of Nebraska-specific abuse/neglect/misappropriation training
- Pass the Nebraska-approved written/oral exam and skills competency exam
- Wait for the facility employer to complete and submit the Registry form to put your name on the state's registry upon hire
