



New Mexico CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete a state-approved CNA training program that includes 75 education hours within the past 24 months
- Complete Prometric's Nurse Aide Testing Application
- Pay the fee(s) to take the New Mexico Nurse Aide Competency Exam administered by Prometric on behalf of the New Mexico Human Services Department and the New Mexico Department of Health
 - Exception: If you're testing for the first and you've been offered employment or you're currently employed by a Medicaid-certified nursing facility, the State of New Mexico pays your fee
- Pass the written and clinical skills part of the competency exam
