



## Oregon CNA Certification Checklist

### CNA Level 1 Certification Applicants Must:

- Complete an Oregon State Board of Nursing-approved level 1 nursing assistant training program of at least 75 hours
- Provide fingerprints for state and federal criminal history record checks through the Oregon State Police and the FBI
- Pass a criminal background check
- Attest to at least 2 hours of cultural competency education in the 2 years before application submission
- Pass the Board-approved competency examination through D&S Diversified Technologies/Headmaster within 1 year of application

*CNA 1 certification applicants in Oregon may perform the authorized duties of a nursing assistant at a licensed nursing facility for up to 120 days from their hire date if they've completed a Board-approved CNA 1 training program.*

### CNA Level 2 Certification Applicants Must:

- Submit a fully completed application established by the Board
- Hold active Oregon CNA 1 certification
- Qualify for CNA 2 training by completing 75 hours of CNA 1 training, 75 work hours as a CNA 1 or a combination of the two
- Pass the training programs' competency evaluation
