



## Pennsylvania CNA Certification Checklist

- Reach at least 16 years of age
- Submit to a PA State Police Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) report before enrolling in a CNA training class
- Submit to an FBI Criminal History report if you haven't been a resident of Pennsylvania for at least the last 2 consecutive years before enrolling in a CNA training class
- Complete an 80-hour Pennsylvania Department of Education-approved nurse aide training program, including 37.5 hours of supervised clinical experience
- Submit a PA Nurse Aide Registry application to Credentia
- Pass the Written/Oral Exam and the Skills Evaluation administered by Credentia on behalf of the Pennsylvania Department of Health

*Must pass the exam within 24 months of program completion.*
