



South Carolina CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete a 100-hour state-approved CNA training program that includes 40 hours of clinical training
- Optional: Work up to 4 months in a Medicaid-certified nursing facility once enrolled in a state-approved training program or have completed a training program but haven't passed the certification exam yet
- Complete an online Application for Registration by Competency Examination form on the Credential Management Services site
- Pass the NNAAP Examination for the South Carolina Nurse Aide Registry administered through Credentia on behalf of the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services

Must pass both exams on the same day and within 24 months of completing a training program to be certified and listed on the SC Nurse Aide Registry.
