



Texas CNA Certification Checklist

- Complete a 100-hour State-approved Nurse Aide Training and Competency Evaluation Program (NATCEP)
- Complete a competency evaluation application and submit it to the Texas Unified License Information Portal (TULIP), specifically designed for licensees and licensed long-term care providers
- Wait for the Texas Health and Human Services to approve you for testing and notify Prometric of your eligibility
- Pass the CNA competency evaluation administered by Prometric
- Get certified to provide services in licensed nursing facilities and skilled nursing facilities

Must pass the competency evaluation within 3 attempts and 24 months of completing the training program.
